1. Entry fee 30p per entry. Children free.
2. A maximum of **2** entries per class per person.
3. Entries **REGISTERED** on the preceding Thursday between 7.00pm and 8.00pm at the Peace Hall or earlier to Janet Barnett 01527 69399/royandjanetb@htomail.co.uk  
(Please have entry form filled in and bring to hall with entries.)
4. **No late entries will be accepted.**
5. Exhibits to be staged (**BROUGHT IN**) between 8.30am and 11.00am on the day of the show.
6. Exhibitors must use vases and containers provided by the Society for Section 1 – except in Classes 1, 11, 17, 20 - 22.
7. All exhibits, to be grown or produced by the exhibitor. Classes 1, & 11 to have been owned by the exhibitor for not less than six months.
8. Judges may withhold prizes if exhibits are deemed to be of insufficient merit.
9. Trophies will be held for one year only and must be returned in good and clean condition to the Show Secretary at least two weeks before the next annual show.
10. **Entrants to adult classes must be 16 years old or over.**
11. The judges' decisions are final.

The Show Secretary/stewards reserve the right to re-site an entry if necessary.
